Must-Visit Places

- **Putra Mosque:** Known as the "Pink Mosque," this rose-tinted architectural marvel is a major landmark.
- **Putrajaya Lake:** A 650-hectare man-made lake perfect for water sports and recreational activities.
- **Putrajaya Botanical Garden:** Malaysia's largest botanical garden, ideal for nature lovers and cyclists.
- **Perdana Putra:** The office complex of the Prime Minister, offering stunning views of the city.
- **Putrajaya Bridge:** The city's main bridge, connecting Heritage Square to the Convention Center.

Shopping

- **IOI City Mall:** The largest mall in Malaysia, housing over 650 outlets. Offers more extensive entertainment options, including District 21 (a post-apocalypse themed recreational park), two ice skating rinks, and a larger cinema complex with IMAX and other premium formats.
